Contractor Management responsibilities are:

- Our Management Team:
 - Determine HSEQ considerations for every project.
 - Review contracts and methodologies to ensure the HSEQ requirements will be met by the contractor.
 - Arrange supervision, training and/or assistance for contracted organisations to assure HSEQ standards.
 - Communicate and coordinate management of WHS legal responsibilities between all organisations involved in service delivery.
 - Ensure contractors' HSEQ methodologies are compatible and do not undermine our HSEQ processes.
- Project Management Teams:
 - $\circ\,$ Provide supervision, training and/or assistance to contractors as required to assure HSEQ standards.
 - \circ Participate in risk assessment and consultation activities with contractors.
 - Supervise and inspect contractor performance and compliance with HSEQ standards.
 - Report non-conformances to the Management Team.
- ✤ Contractors:
 - Provide evidence of HSEQ management capabilities to us.
 - Provide evidence of licenses, training and competency to perform work.
 - $\circ~$ Develop and implement Safe Work Method Statements/Job Safety Analysis, and other risk assessments.
 - Comply with WHS legislation, site rules and participate in inspections and audits where required; and
 - Participate in site consultative arrangements.
 - Communicate and Coordinate management of WHS legal responsibilities between partner organisations.
 - \circ $\;$ Do not allow sub-contractors to attend site without our assessment and approval.
