- Monitor industrial relations performance and activities of subcontractors and suppliers by maintaining effective communication with them, while recognising their right to have their own industrial relations policies and arrangements;
- Ensure union bodies seeking to engage with our employees/ subcontractor employees adhere to all necessary requirements under the FW Act for right of entry, including a formal request and notice period.
- Develop and improve the skills of workers to enable them to work efficiently in a constantly evolving environment and to strive to reach their maximum potential; and
- Accept that the properly held interests of our clients always prevail, and that accordingly it is the client who will in many cases determine actual industrial relations arrangements.

Responsibilities

All levels of management of this company will:

- Provide fair and reasonable management of industrial issues and expect the same from all other interested parties;
- Maintain an open relationship with our workers and any elected representatives, and with other interested parties;
- Apply all policies and procedures in an equitable and fair manner regardless of position;
- Promote open and effective communication between workers at all levels and resolve disputes quickly and efficiently; and
- Encourage open and honest communications at all times in industrial relations matters.
